# WHATS IN YOUR DOG'S FOOD?

Reading the back of a bag of dog food can be like reading Greek if you aren't sure what you are looking for. So we have decided to do a series of articles regarding ingredients you want to see, and those you don't want to see.

Menadione sodium bisulfite (also listed sometimes as Menadione, dimethylpyrimidinol bisulfite, and menadione dimethylprimidinol sulfate) is a synthetic form of vitamin K---vitamin K3 to be exact. So whats so bad about this chemical?

According to *The Dog Food Project*, this ingredient has been blamed for everything from liver cytotoxicity, its mutagenic effects, supressing the immune system, skin irritation and eczema, and even irritation of the mucous membranes. Dog food companies claim that this ingredient is a more digestible form of vitamin K, and helps in blood clotting. Neither of these claims have ever been proven.

What has been proven is that vitamin K3, in high direct doses, causes vomiting and albuminuria (albumin in the urine, usually a sign of of kidney damage). Also according to The Dog Food Proiect. Menadione has never been approved for long-term use (such as in dog food), has been banned from use in food and supplements in many European countries due to serious injury or death, and has been banned by the FDA from over the counter supplements due to it's high toxicity.

# LOWCOUNTRY LOW-COST SPAY/NEUTER OPTIONS

The Beaufort County Animal Shelter is going to have a male cat clinic on Saturday, June 26, at St. Helena Fire Station on Lady's Island. The cost is \$15 for the neuter, and \$5 per shot. The rabies vaccination is mandatory, but other medicines or shots are optional. Dr. Murphy will be performing the operations in his mobile clinic. People who want to participate can call the shelter at 843-846-3904 to put their name on the list. Cats from all over Beaufort County are welcome, not just from your pooch to you. Additionally, every Wednesday and you're here? We can radio Thursday the Hilton Head Humane Association will be hosting a no-cost spay and neuter clinic. The only charge for eligible participants is a \$5.00 microchipping fee. This program is offered to low-income residents, full time college students and owners of Pit Bulls Rottweilers. Call the shelter at 843 681-8686 to confirm eligibility and to make appointments.
